

# PITC Online Infant & Toddler Group Care Course Now Enrolling! Ongoing courses through January 2021.

## **Course Description**

This course focuses on the Program for Infant/Toddler Care (PITC) approach to infant/toddler care and addresses in particular how to support healthy social-emotional development and learning in group care settings.

## **Student Learning Outcomes**

This course will enable students to:

- » Increase knowledge and understanding of a child's emotional and social development;
- » Learn ways to best meet the social-emotional needs of infants and toddlers in group care;
- » Increase knowledge and understanding of how children learn and best ways to facilitate their learning including supporting children with special needs; and
- » Learn about the importance of culture and families.

Participants who successfully complete the course will be eligible for three units through California State University, Fresno.

### Requirements

Course participants (students) will be expected to complete approximately 3-5 hours of coursework per week for 18 weeks. Coursework hours include flexible online "in-class time" and the completion of readings, group discussions, quizzes, assignments and jobembedded practice. Students must have regular access to a computer with an internet connection.

Please note that the PITC Group Care Online course is not a Train-the-Trainer course and does not qualify participants to obtain PITC certification.
